



Amendment to Safety Data Sheet for registration in the BASTA-system

The BASTA system is a self-declaration system. Construction products that do not exceed the concentration threshold for specified environmental and health properties and where the supplier meets a number of terms of qualification can be registered in the BASTA database.

A BASTA-registration of a chemical product may be based on a safety data sheet, drawn up according to ECHAs Guidance on the compilation of safety data sheets (version 1.0, September 2011), supplemented by the following amendment.

We are manufacturing chemical products and/or parts thereof for registration in the BASTA system.

We have studied the terms of agreement and properties criteria of the BASTA system and confirm according to our present knowledge that the products listed below meet the following specifications:

Sub-supplier declaration for the BASTA system

The BASTA system is a self-declaration system with the aim of phasing out hazardous substances from construction products. Construction products that meet maximum acceptable concentrations for specified environmental and health properties and where the supplier meets a number of terms of qualification can be registered in the BASTA system.

The following declaration may serve as a confirmation that those products and/or parts thereof that are not manufactured by the supplier itself, meet the properties criteria of the BASTA system.

We have studied the properties criteria of the BASTA system and the statements 1.0 – 3.0 in the second page of this declaration, and confirm that:

Sub-supplier declaration for the BASTA system

1.0 Assessment and declaration of composition

For products covered by the Sub-supplier declaration, a detailed description of how the assessment is made in relation to the Properties criteria shall be available. The documentation should include the following information:

- 1) substances and/or raw materials
- 2) CAS number or equivalent identification
- 3) the substance or materials percentage by weight of the product or each relevant individual components' total weight
- 4) detailed constituent substances' properties if relevant for qualification

Exception for the accounting of CAS numbers can be made with regards to non-modified naturally occurring raw materials such as minerals, wood and similar articles whose chemical properties are deemed to have no relevance for the registration.

2.0 Competence requirements

Individuals responsible for managing the data stated in the Sub-supplier declaration shall have the following competence:

- 1) good knowledge of health and environmental assessment of chemical substances
- 2) good awareness of the chemical composition of the products
- 3) good awareness of the European regulatory system for chemicals legislation
- 4) good knowledge of the classification and labelling of chemical substances

Above mentioned competence should consist either of individuals employed at the Company or an, by the Company hired, external consultant

3.0 Secrecy conditions

The auditor contracted by BASTAonline commits not to disclose information that the auditor receives from the Company considered as the Company's trade secret, such as information about the Company's operations, suppliers and underlying verifications that the auditors obtains. This obligation does not affect such information that the auditor or BASTAonline are obliged to make available under a provision of law or regulation or by official regulatory decision.
